Dear Parent/Guardian,

Primary-Secondary Transition 2021

At Castlehead High School we are very much aware of the challenging, unusual circumstances that we find ourselves in due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the impact that this has had on our day to day lives.

We are keen to reassure you that supporting a smooth transition between Primary 7 and S1 remains a priority for everyone at Castlehead. We would like to update you on what we have already done and what we will be doing to support the transition process.

Our transition process has been running over the last year. We have been working closely with staff in the primary schools to ensure smooth transfer of information, including friendship groups etc. to allow us to place pupils in the most appropriate class. Our Support for Learning team and home link have been involved throughout the transition process to ensure that we have appropriate support plans in place for pupils where needed.

Transition Programme

In place of our usual 3-day induction visit pupils will have the opportunity to take part in the transition activities below:

- **Literacy Transition Project**
Delivered by CHS English Department staff
- **Virtual Assembly/Q+A session**
Delivered by Mr Macdonald (HT) and some of our S6 pupils
- **Pathway to Castlehead workshop**
Delivered by the CHS Pupil Support Team
- **Technical/Design Challenge**
Delivered by CHS Technical Department staff

In addition, pupils will have a visit to Castlehead.

The visit to Castlehead for Glencoats pupils will take place on **Tuesday 22nd June**. Pupils should arrive at Glencoats at their usual time and will be transported by bus to Castlehead. Pupils will return to Glencoats in time for their usual lunch break.

During their visit, pupils will remain in their existing class bubbles and strict COVID risk assessment/guidance will be followed.

Although pupils do not currently need to wear a face covering in Glencoats, pupils (unless exempt) will be required to wear a face covering at all times whilst in the Castlehead building.

During the visit pupils will be taking part in some outdoor activities, so are permitted to wear their own suitable clothing, rather than their school uniform.

Parental engagement

We are also running a programme of virtual parent/carer information sessions and workshops to support the transition process.
