
Head Teacher Update

Along with her parents and Glasgow Children's Hospital Charity, she helped to set up Another Star in the Sky in his memory. Despite her grief, she has taken part in numerous charity events and raised approximately £20 000 for research into AVM, the rare condition that took her brother, and to fund bereavement services. She has also campaigned for the inclusion of compulsory bereavement education into the Scottish school curriculum. She will be completing the Kilt Walk on Sunday to raise more money to support Glasgow Children's Hospital Charity. Congratulations again Mariya!
