Head Teacher Weekly Update

Dear Pupils, Parent/Carer,

At this time of year, we usually begin the stretch to winter with the darker nights closing in and the temperature dropping. Fortunately, we seem to be having an extended stretch of warm weather. Yesterday, I messaged all parents to inform them that for the remainder of this week, we would be accepting pupils wearing shorts due to the high temperatures. The temperatures are due to drop after the weekend, so the expectation will be that we will return to our expected school uniform from Monday. 
