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### <u>SQA Exam Timetable</u>

All Senior Phase pupils who are sitting National 5, Higher or Advanced Higher qualifications will be issued an individual timetable for their SQA exams this week.

As you will be aware our SQA exams will take place both in the school and the Lagoon. Pupils should check the location of their exams, and ensure they arrive in good time for the start of their exams. Please note that pupils will leave from the school where exams take place at the Lagoon.

Pupils should ensure that they bring all the required equipment and a copy of their Scottish Candidate Number with them.

### <u>SQA Exam Attendance</u>
