## Review of Renfrewshire Council's Anti-Bullying Policy

Renfrewshire Council is currently reviewing its Anti-Bullying Policy. This is to ensure it is fully aligned with the national anti-bullying guidance, Respect for All, which was developed by respectme, Scotland's Anti-Bullying Service. The Anti-Bullying Policy being reviewed is a Renfrewshire Council policy that applies across all schools within the local authority. Once agreed, the updated policy will provide the framework that schools will use to review and inform their own school anti-bullying policies and procedures.
